

# Operation: Water Festival



## Welcome Teachers.

You and your “Special Agents” (aka your students) have been recruited by the **Water Bureau of Investigation (WBI)**. Let your Special Agents spring into action: exploring, observing, thinking, and uncovering the secret, and not so secret, world of water!

Operation Water Festival provides a fun and intriguing venue for your students to learn the critical nature of preserving and protecting our water sources and remaining safe in the event of a flood.



This folio, provided by WBI Headquarters (aka **WASH**), contains a complete, turnkey mini-curriculum for you to use as a primer for Operation Water Festival. Included are exciting activities, demonstrations and investigations to engage your students and make learning about water a blast!

Teachers, **your mission** is to lead your Special Agents through the curriculum over the four weeks prior to Operation Water Festival. All the tools needed to complete your mission are in your folio.

### Folio Contents:

**WEEKLY PROCEEDINGS:**

1. Review the **teacher guide** for detailed instructions and background information.

2. **Present background information** contained in each unit, handout the student activity sheets and communicate the mission to your Special Agents.

3. Send the **Special Agents home with their Agent**

**Training Blue Book; ask them to read the unit’s corresponding information; take the short three-question assessment provided; and attempt to crack the code word for that week’s unit.** The code words are integral to deciphering the master encrypted message in the back of the Blue Book.

4. **Have two Student Water Agents** (formerly Student Water Ambassadors) collect the Blue Books each week and place corresponding stamps in each student’s Blue Book when unit assignment is correctly completed.
